To know the Human Genome, To be able to define the mechanisms responsible for the regulation of cell death and to give examples of related diseases, To know the inheritance mechanisms and to give examples of diseases related to these mechanisms, To be competent in genetic technologies used in the field of medicine and to give examples of the areas of use of these technologies, To explain the areas of application in regenerative medicine and medicine. To define the biosafety rules that will ensure safe application in the laboratory, To know the procedures for DNA isolation from blood and microorganisms, PCR and electrophoresis applications.

To learn the structures, functions, action mechanisms, and symptoms related to deficiency and toxicity of vitamins and bioelements, To understand the functions of nutrients in energy expenditure and requirement. To explain the chemical properties and organization of the cell membrane, understand the transport mechanisms in the membrane, discuss how transport processes are modulated. To describe the biological redox reactions and mechanisms pathway, explain the components and mechanisms of the electron transport system and oxidative phosphorylation. To learn that the oxygen, which is essential for life, can also be toxic and define these processes.

Defines histological features of connective tissue, recognizes connective tissue types, cells, and fibers. Explains histological structure of blood tissue and its cells, defines details of biogenesis of blood tissue and their relationship with functions. Names and functions of cells forming bone tissue and its matrix, defines their organization. Defines the types of ossification. Explains types of cartilage, its matrix and cells forming it. Explains processes of spermatogenesis and oogenesis, tells their differences. Explains events and features occurring in fertilization, tells results of fertilization. Explains implantation process, explains bilaminar germ disc formation. Explains trilaminar germ disc formation and neurulation and explains which structures are formed from them.

Medical Faculty students, who will undertake the task of maintaining the health of the human body and healing diseased bodies, will begin learning Anatomy in this course module with the universal scientific disciplines of Medical Terminology and Osteology. Medical Terminology and Osteology are the cornerstones of understanding and learning the naming, organization, and structure of formations in the human body. Medical Terminology consists of universal terms that explain all anatomical formations, regions, diseases, clinical applications, diagnostic, and imaging methods of the human body, making communication within the global medical community easier. Active movement in the human body is the voluntary change of place and position of any part of the body. The most

important anatomical structures that functionally perform this process are part of the movement system. The anatomical formations within the field of Osteology constitute the fundamental structure of the human body. Learning about bones facilitates our understanding and systematic and topographic placement of joints, muscles, vessels, nerves, membranes, and all organs in the human body.

Physiology, tries to solve the secrets of survival of living organisms. Life requires complex control systems. Approximately 100 trillion cells in the human body interact with each other and try to provide suitable conditions for each other. In this committee, the conditions that ensure the vitality of the organism will be examined.

The Effective Patient-Physician Interview course aims to provide medical students with communication skills that will strengthen the patient-physician relationship. The main goal of this course is to ensure that students develop basic communication competencies such as empathy, active listening, openness and trust. In addition, it is aimed to make them aware of issues such as accurate information transfer, confidentiality and ethical values in patient-physician interviews. In multidisciplinary practice laboratories, it is aimed to provide students with practical applications with simulated patients along with theoretical knowledge, and to enable them to establish safe and effective communication with patients.

To prepare a written assignment by accessing evidence-based information on a given medical topic by using library contents, digital contents and digital databases with which the university has agreements, and to present this information on the panel.
