


How can I access a virtual classroom in an Ultra course view?



Login using the Chrome, Microsoft Edge browser.


Access the platform at https://olearn.okan.edu.tr/

Login to the O'Learn platform with your OIS (Student Information System) username and password.




Enter the courses section and select your course.

After logging into your course, click Class Collab.





You can view your previous classes from the 'Previous' section.










Click the 'Join on the web' button.




Click the 'Continue' button on the opened screen.



You can select the seating arrangement from the 'Seating Chart' section.




You can choose the number of users to be displayed from the specified area.




You can turn your microphone on and off from the highlighted area.

You can adjust your microphone settings from the options within the red area.




You can turn your camera on and off from the highlighted area.


When you activate your camera, you can select your virtual background.




Click on the 'Syllabus' option in the 'Learning Tools' section located on the bottom panel.




You can view and download the course schedule shared by your instructor.




Click on the 'Files' option in the 'Learning Tools' section located on the bottom panel.




You can view and download the files previously shared by your instructor.




Click on the 'Grades' option in the 'Learning Tools' section located on the bottom panel.




You can view all your assignment and quiz grades you have participated in during the session.

- You can enable the option to share the sound of the screen you are sharing from the 'Also share tab audio'.







After sharing the screen, you can adjust the screen size from the 'View Options' option.

You can stop screen sharing from the 'Stop Sharing' and 'Pause Sharing' option.


You can continue screen sharing in the 'Resume Sharing' option.




From the 'Chat' area in the lower panel, you can access the chat channels.





From the 'Participants' area in the lower panel, you can view all users.



You can activate the subtitle feature from the More option and adjust the font size.











- In the 'Reaction' area, you can share your selected reaction with the entire class using the 'Share it Everyone' option.
- With the 'Share with Instructors and Presenters' option, you can share your reactions only with instructors and presenters.
- You can delete your reaction using the 'Clear Reaction' option.
- When you want to raise your hand, click the 'Raise hand' button.



Click on the 'Leave' option to exit the class.
