COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

1. PACE101GR Pre-Intermediate Grammar

As designed with a grammar-in-context approach, this course focuses on English grammar from elementary to intermediate. Students practice the language, using essential structures to build spoken and written English communication, as well as through self-evaluation and online activities.

2. PACE101R Reading

This course equips students with fundamental reading skills, including skimming, scanning, previewing, and guessing vocabulary in context. In addition, it focuses on recognizing parts of speech, distinguishing facts from opinions, and making inferences. With pre-and in-class activities, the course helps students explicitly understand short texts and find specific information.

3. PACE101W Writing

This course helps students develop competence in written communication by practicing precise and concise academic writing. In the class, students learn how to effectively use sentence patterns, linking words, transitions, and punctuation to produce well-organized essays.

4. PACE101LS Pre- Intermediate Listening and Speaking

This course helps students develop essential skills in listening and speaking. With strategies to listen to and understand people effectively, it encourages students to take notes and organize their ideas. In addition, by pressing self-confidence, the course helps students learn new vocabulary, participate in discussions, and express themselves with acceptable accuracy in speaking.

5. PACE103GR Intermediate Grammar I

This course helps students progress their grammar skills from intermediate to upper-intermediate. By practicing grammar, the course encourages students to write academic paragraphs or essays, test their knowledge, and demonstrate an understanding of more complex grammatical structures in conversations and discussions. In addition, it helps students differentiate between various tenses and their usage in English through online activities and self-evaluation.

6. PACE103RW Reading and Writing I

This course improves reading and writing skills and expands English vocabulary through various articles selected from history, culture, science, and health.

7. PACE103LS Intermediate Listening and Speaking I

The course helps students understand a lesson and analyze its components at intermediate and post-Intermediate levels. It enables students to learn note-taking skills and practice them during while-listening tasks. The course encourages students to participate in discussions and in-class activities. Students are exposed to a broad English vocabulary, idioms, and structures and are expected to use them while expressing their ideas. The course also includes describing charts, graphs, and diagrams.

8. PACE104GR Intermediate Grammar II

This course aims students to develop and understand their grammar skills and progress at B2 (CEFR) level. Learners will practice their grammar knowledge in contexts. It focuses on using more complicated, sophisticated grammar, especially in writing well-organized essays. Through online grammar self-tests, students have an opportunity to assess their progress.

9. PACE104RW Reading and Writing II

This course helps students improve their reading and writing skills and expand their B2 (CEFR) vocabulary. It provides students with various articles such as history, culture, science, health, etc., encouraging them to write integrated essays. The course includes critical reading, engagement in extensive-longer reading, analysis (arguments) and evaluation, and then writing well-organized essays such as opinion, descriptive, cause and effect, etc., and description of more different charts/graphs.

10. PACE104LS Intermediate Listening and Speaking II

Through academic lectures at the post-Intermediate level, this course helps students understand a lesson and analyze its components. It includes extended audio or video lectures on art, science, technology, literature, business, etc. It enables learners to study note-taking skills and practice them on 'before, while, and after listening' tasks. The course encourages participating in discussions and in-class activities and acquiring a broad English vocabulary, idioms, phrases, and structures to use while expressing ideas. It includes describing charts, graphs, and diagrams.
