Smoke-Free Campus Policy

Istanbul Okan University is a world university focused on the ideal of serving the development of people and humanity, respecting the Sustainable Development Goals and adopting continuous development as a principle.

Istanbul Okan University, together with its students, academic and administrative staff, graduates and all its stakeholders, has adopted the principle of taking protective measures and precautions against the harms of tobacco products and ensuring that everyone can breathe clean air.

With this policy, all stakeholders, including corridors, for all kinds of educational, health, social, cultural, sports, entertainment and similar purposes, indoor areas of buildings where more than one person can enter, and places where all kinds of sports, culture, art and entertainment activities are carried out outdoors. It is aimed to prevent tobacco products from being consumed in their viewing areas.

The main legal frameworks, external academic standards and external reference points used to ensure a smoke-free campus in accordance with this policy are as follows:
